English

During this half term, our English curriculum will feature two exciting class texts: 'Wonder' and 'How We Lived in Ancient Times'. Students will write diary entries inspired by *Wonder*, enhancing their empathy and narrative skills. Additionally, they will research and write a report on Ancient Greece, deepening their understanding of historical contexts and report writing.

Maths

During this half term, Year 6, we will focus on post-SATs consolidation and engaging in Maths topic on finances with the Newcastle United Foundation (NUFC). This program aims to reinforce foundational Maths skills and apply them to real-world financial scenarios, helping students understand budgeting, money management, and financial literacy.

Science

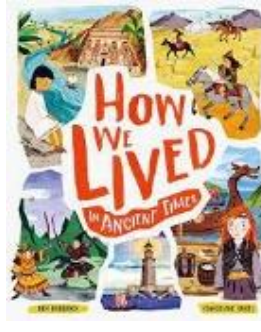
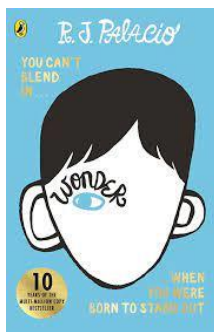
In Year 6, will be engaging in a "Think Like a Scientist" topic, designed to reaffirm their understanding of working scientifically as they prepare for the transition to high school. Focusing on the theme of sound, children will plan and carry out their own enquiries to answer scientific questions. They will use a range of equipment to collect data for their objectives.

RE

In Year 6, our RE curriculum will cover several important topics. We will finish the topic of healing by exploring the Sacrament of the Sick. Then, we will study Islam, focusing on the Five Pillars of Islam. Our final topic will be the Universal Church, with a theme of the common good and how to work together worldwide as a Christian family.

Geography

In Year 6, our Geography curriculum will include an exciting fieldwork project comparing the Ouseburn to the inner city, focusing on both human and physical features. Children will observe, measure, record, and present these features using various methods such as sketch maps, plans, graphs, and digital technologies. They will also use the 8 points of a compass, 4- and 6-figure grid references, symbols, and keys (including Ordnance Survey maps) to enhance their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world.



Computing

In Year 6, our computing curriculum will focus on manipulating images. Children will select, use, and combine a variety of software, including internet services, on different digital devices. They will design and create programs, systems, and content to achieve specific goals, including, collecting, analysing, evaluating, and presenting data and information.

Design Technology

In Year 6, our Design Technology curriculum will focus on designing a motor for continuous movement. Children will use research to develop design criteria, generate ideas through sketches and prototypes, and use various tools and materials for practical tasks.

PSHE

In PSHE, Created to Live in Community explores the individual's relationship with the wider world. Here we explore how human beings are relational by nature and are called to love others in the wider community through service, through dialogue and through working for the Common Good. In Life to the Full. Plus, learning on money and careers is concluded, using previous learning from the module to understand God's call to live generously.

PE

In Year 6, our PE curriculum will focus on leadership in PE and the Olympic Games. Children will develop leadership skills through organizing and leading activities, and will learn about the history and values of the Olympic Games, participating in related sports and events to enhance their physical abilities and teamwork.

French

The children will create a compound written sentence by using a conjunction., they will know and use a range of masculine and feminine ordinary nouns Give a definition and example of: an ordinary noun, a pronoun and an adjective.
