Year 4 Spring term 2

English

During this half term in English we studying the Roald Dahl classic 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' and writing a narrative from another point of view. After this unit, children will focus on the video clip 'The Creature'. Children will then plan, write and edit their own newspaper article about the importance of caring for the environment. During the week we will have two separate SPAG lessons

Maths

During this half term we will start looking at decimals which coincides with our fraction's topic. Children will be learning how to calculate divide and multiply decimals. Children's fluency of timetables will be continued focusing on 8's, 9's and 12's. We will end the half term with the unit of time. Children will be converting digital to the 24-hour clock.

PE

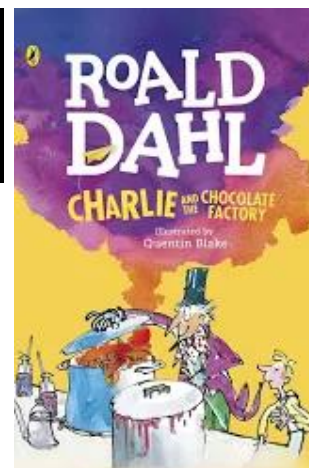
In PE, The Falcons rugby team will be coming in on Mondays to teach a Rugby Unit. Focusing on Invasion skills. Furthermore Year 4 will be doing Gymnastics on a Friday.

RE

In RE, children will be finishing the Sacrament of the Eucharist topic where we evaluate the stages of the mass and how Catholics celebrate the Eucharist. After that, we start the new unit Self Discipline through Lent, where we are Celebrating growth to new life through self-discipline.

Geography

In Geography In the "Resources" topic, children will explore the different resources found around the world, such as food, water, minerals, and trade goods. They will learn about the importance of these resources in everyday life, how they are distributed, and how countries rely on them for economic growth, aswell as focusing on fair trade around the world.



Computing

Children will learn about Online Safety where they will Describe how to search over multiple platforms and be aware of the accuracy of the results presented. They will also describe some of the methods used to persuade people to buy online and explain the difference between fact, opinion and belief and recognise these online.

Art

In Art, we will be creating Landscapes with the theme of mountains. We will be studying Bob Ross as our artist study and using his work to inspire us to create our own mountainous landscapes.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning Unit 3 of Ten Ten – life online and relationships with other. It focuses on teaching children about relationships with others in an age-appropriate and engaging way.

Science

In our Science lessons children are exploring the topic of living things and their habitats understanding life processes and animal groupings. They will learn to sort living things using a variety of criteria and extend their use of scientific vocabulary to describe the features and characteristics of animals and plants. They will conduct a local habitat search and learn to identify unknown living things using a classification key. Children will consider how environmental change impacts the local area and suggest ways humans can prevent further damage

French

Children will be practising every day greetings aswell as revising numbers, colours, and animals. We will extend our learning about routines in school and classroom equipment.
