## Year 6 Autumn Term 2

### English

In English, we will be looking at newspaper reports and explanation texts. In spelling we will be focusing on: adjectives ending in -ant into nouns ending in ance/ancy, homophones and hyphen words. We will also look into World War one poetry and create some of our own.

### Maths

We will be looking at efficient arithmetic skills, long division method and fractions. We will explore shape and angles looking at key knowledge that could help us answer reasoning questions. In fractions we will look at how to add fractions, subtract, multiply and divide fractions. We will apply this knowledge to SATs practise during this half term.

### Science

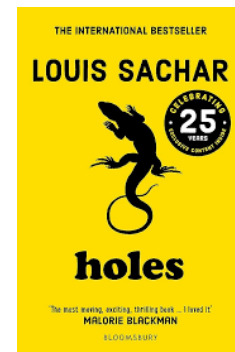
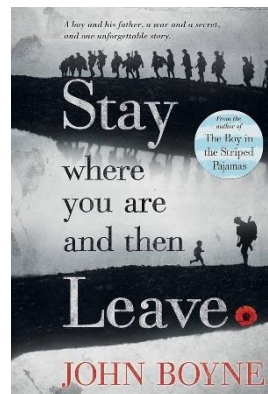
In Science, we will research the parts and functions of the circulatory system. Then will focus on how nutrients are transported around the human body. Then we will explore how a healthy lifestyle supports the body to function and how different types of drugs affect the body.

### RE

In RE, we will be focusing on the theme of Love. We will examine both the love and care from people as well we God's unconditional love. We will learn how the vocation to priesthood involves love and commitment. In other faiths, we will learn about Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kipper.

### History

We are continuing our 'Conflict through Time' history lessons, students will explore pivotal moments that have shaped civilizations. They will investigate themes such as invasion and conquest, analysing how historical conflicts influenced societies.



### Art

Year 6 children will embark on an exciting journey into the world of architecture, with a special focus on the visionary work of Zaha Hadid. Known for her bold, futuristic designs and ground-breaking approach to structures, Hadid's work will inspire children to think creatively about shapes, forms, and spaces. Through hands-on projects and discussions, they will explore how architecture combines art and functionality, encouraging them to develop their own imaginative designs.

### Music
