# Year 6 Spring Term 1

# **English**

During this half term in English, we will be looking at recounts/Diary entries. We will also be looking at how to write in a role of a character looking at shifts in formality. Our spellings will be around Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in -fer.

# Maths

We will be looking at more complex fraction problems and looking at decimals and percentages. In fractions we will look at how to add fractions, subtract, multiply and divide fractions. We will apply this knowledge to SATs practise during this term.

# Science

In Science, we will be looking at Evolution and inheritance where children will gain an understanding of that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.


#### RE

In RE, we will focus in on two topics the first being local church where we will explore sources and children will know how to use the bible as a reference point. The second topic will be our Eucharist topic where we will focus on the theme of unity.

# History

In History children will explore the Victorian era. They will look at the inventions that Victorians developed to change the world, the British empire, influential people during the Victorian period, comparing the role of children to modern day and the Victorian era and finally life inside a workhouse.





#### Art

In Art we will be looking at 3D sculptures/printing/textiles to do with Viking art. This will be an opportunity to revise our first history topic to relate to the society of the Vikings.

## Music

In Music, we will start the year off with A New Year Carol Classical or Urban Gospel -Benjamin Britten's music and cover versions.

# **PSHE**

We will be continuing our Life to the Full topics, looking at emotional changes, making babies and menstruation. We will also have NUFC coming in to do some PSHE work with us on Fridays too.

In PE, we will be looking at net and wall games with NUFC and then exploring the world of gymnastics movements.
