English

During this half term in English, we will be looking at how to write powerful suspenseful stories. We will also be looking at how to write to persuade with reference to characters' decisions from our class text 'A monster calls'. Our spellings will be around statutory year 5 and 6 spellings.

Maths

We will be looking at ratio, algebra, position/direction and measurement. We will apply this knowledge to SATs practise during this half term. We will continue to develop our reasoning and arithmetic skills in weekly maths basic skills sessions.

Science

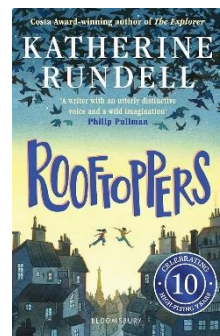
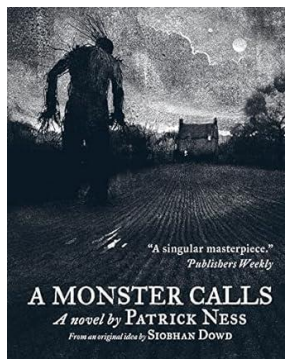
In Science, we will be looking at electricity and how a complete circuit actually occurs. We will test how adding and removing components in a circuit impacts output in a circuit. We will explore how electricity is made whilst also looking at sustainability of electrical sources.

RE

In RE, we will focus in on two topics the first being will be our Eucharist topic where we will focus on the theme of unity. The second topic will be our Lenten topic where we will focus on the theme of death and new life.

SATs practise

We have a SATs focused topic lesson that will take place where we will focus on exam technique and how to apply the skills that have been taught to the exam style questions we will be facing.



Design and Technology

In DT, we will be looking how to design a phone case by assessing functionality for purpose and design for purpose.

Computing

In computing, we will start off at looking at microbits and how we can code and programme them using block coding.

PSHE

We will be continuing our Life to the Full topics, looking at emotional changes, making babies and menstruation. We will also be looking at how to handle anxiety for the upcoming SATs season.

PE

In PE, we will be looking at invasion games with NUFC and then exploring the world of dance movements.

French

In French, we will be looking at modules 3 and 4 which explore places found in their local community.
